Grade 1 Supply List

All Grade 1 students will be required to bring the following to school. Consider bringing these items with you to the back-to-school barbeque.

- **3-4 boxes of Kleenex** (does not need to be labeled)
- 1 pair of "indoor shoes" (running shoes please) that are suitable for Physical Education (rubber soled; comfortable; easy to get on and off and <u>able to fasten themselves</u>) These will stay in the classroom for the year. (NOTE: have your child practice putting them on and taking them off to ensure they are comfortable and suitable for all school activities)
- 1 pair of wired headphones in a baggie, labelled with your child's name: these are used for MAP testing, listening centers, and occasional computer assignments.
- **1 pencil case to store pencil crayons**, made of fabric and labelled with your child's name.
- A set of 24 pencil crayons (pre-sharpened)
- A reusable water bottle labelled with your child's name.
- A reusable lunch bag labelled with your child's name.
- A bag clearly labeled with your child's name containing a pair of dry socks and pants to be used in case of sickness, accidents, or as they learn to play outside around mud and puddles. This bag will stay at school and only be sent home with wet or dirty clothing if needing to be washed and returned. If there is not a change of clothing at school, you may be asked to bring them when needed.
- **Optional**: exercise mat for outdoor lessons and reading time. Please label with your child's name.
- **Optional: A clear plastic folder** (approx.. 9" x12") with student's name permanent and visible preferably one made of durable plastic as these folders will be sent back and forth to school every day. For example:
