(Too) Many Thoughts from our Principal ...

Hello WCS!

It is a new week ahead and we are so thankful for our God who is constant, loving and faithful. We have the privilege of joining together in this school building with which the Lord has blessed us, day after day, year after year. Moreover, our WCS community of families and staff, is a deep blessing that our Father provides. We are so grateful. This is something to reflect upon as we celebrate Thanksgiving at this Wednesday Worship as well as next Monday.

Last Wednesday Worship, we had an opportunity to talk about our school, the hospitality we offer each other and the culture that we want to establish here at WCS.

Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. (I Peter 4:8-9)

We have been talking about love and hospitality, but what are practical examples that we can keep in mind? Here are five points:

- 1. Stop and say, "Hello," or "How are you doing?" and listen for an answer.
- 2. Look at people in the eyes when possible, or wave or offer a warm greeting.
- 3. Say, "Please," and "Thank you," and "Pardon me?" if you don't hear someone well.
- 4. Hold the door for others. Let others go first. Think of others before thinking of yourself.
- 5. Invite others to join you in a game or a discussion, and don't get angry when playing a game.

As students and adults, we can all benefit from remembering how God loves us first and how He wants us to treat others. This is what we call a hospitable and caring culture that we want to continue creating here at WCS.

One of the important groups of people (because there are many!) who also continue to create culture at WCS is our Board. There are ten members who are parents or former parents of the school. They spend hours and hours and hours working, discussing, brainstorming ideas and praying for WCS, particularly as it relates to guiding the school and growing together. You will notice that in this Weekly, they are starting to provide a consistent and brief update on what is happening. We have two membership meetings for a fuller report on the school, one in the fall and one in the spring. So please keep your eye out for these important events and plan to attend.

One quick invitation that I would like to extend is a cup of coffee (or water) that we could share together, here at the school after our Wednesday Worship this week, October 9th. It is a small way to learn more and more about each other, which I really have appreciated about WCS in my short time here already.

Lastly, please keep praying for the school – the students and staff, the events and the building, the interactions and especially the transformation of our hearts and minds to love God and each other deeply. Thank you, Lord, for loving us more than we can ever imagine!
