THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

ABSENCES: If your child will not be at school (due to illness, travel, etc.) or he/she will be arriving late, please email the office and respective teachers BEFORE 8:00 am EVERY DAY that your child is away (with the exception of travel dates).

LATE ARRIVALS: Your child will be marked LATE if they arrive after the 8:35 am bell has rung. They must check into the office before heading to class.

MID-DAY APPOINTMENTS: If your child needs to be off-site for an appointment during the day, email the office in the morning. Your child will wait outside the office. Please ring the front buzzer. Mrs. Santiago will open the door and you can pick up your child.

PARENTS COMING INTO THE SCHOOL

<u>MORNINGS</u> - With the exception of Kindergarten students, we ask that parents drop off their child outside. For security purposes, we cannot permit parents to walk their child directly to their classroom. If your child is late, please allow them to enter the school on their own.

END OF DAY PICK UP: Kindergarten parents are to pick up their child from the Kindergarten door beside the principal's office. All other children are to be picked up at the NORTH GATE parking lot gate between **3:30 and 3:50**. The principal/staff will be at the gate to dismiss the student to the parent.

PARKING: PLEASE REMEMBER TO LEAVE SPACE BETWEEN YOUR CAR AND THE GATE WHEN PARKING so that everyone can walk along the gate. Do not park on the desigated spots with the named sign. **DO NOT WALK BEHIND CARS**.

STUDENTS LEAVING THE SCHOOL WITH SOMEONE OTHER THAN A PARENT:

It is required that all students leave the school property with their parent/guardian or via WCS school bus. If your child REGULARLY (on a weekly basis) is picked up by another adult, please inform the office of the alternate pick-up person(s) name(s).

If your child plans to leave the property with another adult (i.e. birthday party, playdate, etc.) you MUST inform the office PRIOR TO 2:00 pm on that particular day.

STUDENT LEAVING SCHOOL PROPERTY ON THEIR OWN: Must fill out the Unsupervised Dismissal Permision Form. This form can be picked up at the office.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE: Runs from 3:30-6pm. School doors are locked and we ask that the parent enters through the gym doors.

SNACKS & LUNCHES: Please remember that WCS is a nut-free environment so any food with even traces of nuts is not to be brought to school at any time. Please also be mindful of the environment by striving towards waste-free lunches by making use of reusable containers or at least those which can be recycled.

SCHOOL DRESS CODE: Please be sure that your child wears the proper clothing as set out in the school's Dress Code document. We appreciate your compliance. This school is a mask safe zone for all that choose to wear a mask.
